St. Joseph Parish Renovation: St. Joseph Pastoral Council and Finance Committee have been discussing what our new pews should look like to complete the renovation of our Church. We now have a sample pew with the features we have chosen. I hope you will be able to see it soon, sit on it and use the kneelers to see what an improvement it will be. We anticipate that they will arrive in early August.

We started an account to fund these pews at the beginning of the year but are short of the total needed. It will cost about \$220 per seat or \$650 for a 5' pew. Over the last several years we have made some significant changes - new roof and furnaces in Reuter Hall, replaced some sidewalk and paved the parking area on Lafayette, new St. Joseph and Child Statue, lettering, lighting outdoors along with the new carpeting, energy efficient lighting, sound system and painting of the ceiling and walls in Church. All those were made possible by generous donations to our Memorial Fund so we didn't need to ask for additional money from parishioners. But we do need your financial help for this final phase of replacing the pews. Please mark your donation "St. Joseph Pew Fund" and thank you for your generosity in supporting this project.
