### **SHOP FOR CHINANDEGA THIS SUMMER!**

Very early this September, 2016, the Waterloo Downtown Rotary Club will be collecting boxes of items to be sent as Christmas presents to children living in Chinandega, Nicaragua. These boxes are an important part of encouraging these young people to receive an education which can help them to escape from poverty. The Bosco System has again offered to fill 300 boxes about the size of a large shoebox. Because they will be needed so early in the school year, we have already begun preparations.

The boxes will be picked up by the first week in September. In order to be ready for pick up then, we need to receive all items by August 30<sup>th</sup>. Since school begins August 25<sup>th</sup>, the building will be open and items can be brought into the school all that week. That will give us one week to go through the boxes to make sure they have all necessary items.

**The sign-up for boxes is beginning now.** If you or your family would like to fill a box or boxes, both the Don Bosco (296-1692 or 827-6056) and the Immaculate Conception (296-1089) offices will have sign-up sheets and will be able to accept calls during office hours, OR, you may call Mrs. Hellman (319-231-8151) any time this summer to choose a boy or a girl of a certain age.

We are starting to prepare for our return **mission trip to Guatemala** through the global help organization International Samaritan.
