Immaculate Conception Parish Rosary Society Dues- How important is it to pay your Rosary Society dues? Every month the parish purchases the Altar Breads and Wine with the money we budget from Rosary Society dues, this bill averages \$77 each month or \$924 per year. We did not collect enough dues last year to cover the cost completely, we are currently at a break even point in dues collected this year. July 1st we will begin a new fiscal year.
