School Bus for Sale: We are selling our activity school bus. This is being sold as-is. The school bus is a 2003 and has 114,000 miles on it. This is a snub nose 72 passenger bus. The reason for needing to sell the bus is because it didn't pass the most recent school bus inspection. We have been looking over the past several weeks at a bus to replace this and any proceeds for the sell of this bus will be going towards are next bus purchase.

We took the bus to School Bus Sales in Waterloo to get more information on what it would take to fix. Below is the description they provided for your information.

WE HAVE LOOKED AT BUS 3 AND FLOOR PAN OVER REAR AXLE NEEDS REPLACED, FOR THIS REPAIR SIDE PANELS OVER WHEEL WELL NEED REMOVED AND PROBABLY WILL NOT BE ABLE TO BE REUSED, SEATS AND FLOORING WILL NEED TO BE REMOVED, FLOORING CAN NOT BE REUSED---REAR DOOR AND LEFT TAG PANEL HAVE EXTENSIVE RUSTING AND PROBABLY WILL NOT PASS NEXT INSPECTION
