The buildings and ground crew will look into it's effect on grass etc. The Building and Grounds committee is also looking into lights in the steeple below the bells which will light up through the stained glass windows in the steeple at night. Waiting patiently for weather to cooperate so that they can finish the exterior lights around the church. Repairs will be made on the sign outside church and will illuminate it better. Organ repair is completed. The council looked over the bid for Buggy's pest control for the rectory and the church and decided to accept.
