

Immaculate Conception Pastoral Council Minutes
Wednesday, May 22, 2019

1. Jammi called the meeting to order at 6:02 PM
2. Fr. Huber led us in prayer.
3. Motion to approve the agenda and minutes from the April 2019 meeting was made by Brian Nie and seconded by Julie Frost
4. Committee Reports:
 - A. Finance and Administration – The Council looked over the April Summary of Accounts and all felt we are in good shape. Fr. Huber went over the options for distribution of CFAD interest on Gilbertville Educational Endowment Fund. The Council voted to write a check to the Bosco Catholic School System for the amount, approximately \$22,200.00. For the interest earned on the Immaculate Conception Educational Trust, approximately \$1,000.00, the Council voted to just leave the amount in the Trust.
 - B. Board of Education – Fr. Huber reported that open positions are being filled but we will not be replacing the Consumer Science position.
 - C. Community Life and Social Concerns – Nothing to Report
 - D. Spiritual Growth and Liturgy – Fr. Huber said that the committee reviewed the Easter season and made plans for Corpus Christi. Fr. Huber said that the special Mass on the evening of May 15th for Mental Health Awareness was very well attended.
 - E. Building and Grounds: It was reported that Steve Reiter talked to John Huff concerning the new hand railing for the handicapped parking area. Out door lightening project will continue when weather cooperates. Bart Samuelson replaced the overgrown bushes in the front of church and will replace others as the parish requests. Janet checked with the grotto at Dickyville WI for advice on repairing the Grotto. Unfortunately they too need some repairs and are having difficulty finding someone with that skill set.
 - F. Deanery Council – Council meets next week. Fr. reported that the last two meetings had to be cancelled.
5. Unfinished Business: Parish Elections- Abbie Frost and Brian Nie were elected to the Pastoral Council.

6. New Business: Fr. Huber distributed a questionnaire from CFAD for the Pastoral Council to complete at this meeting.

7. Father Huber's Comments: Fr. Huber would like to have a weekday Mass that is available for parishioners that are still working. Beginning June 5 the 7:45 AM Wednesday Masses at Immaculate Conception will be changed to 6:00 PM. He will also have Adoration beginning at 5:00 PM and Fr. Huber will offer confessions until Benediction right before Mass. Therefore all Pastoral Council meetings will now begin following the Wednesday Mass.
